Laurel - the Hub of Montana!

Thank you for your interest in the Laurel community and area. We are always happy to have the opportunity to brag about the city of Laurel and the Big Sky State of Montana.

Laurel, the largest city in Montana that is not a county seat, is truly the "Hub of Montana." From here, all roads lead to the exciting, historical and recreational attractions of Montana and Wyoming. Spend a little time in our friendly community while you make your travel decisions.

From here, you can select one of four outstanding entrances into Yellowstone National Park. The Cody entrance, the Red Lodge/Beartooth Highway entrance, the Gardiner entrance or the West Yellowstone entrance are all easily accessed from Laurel. Two major highways south will take you to Wyoming. Head east to Montana's largest city, Billings, and further to the most prominent Lewis and Clark landmark, Pompey's Pillar. Little Bighorn Battlefield (once called Custer's Battlefield), site of the most famous Indian battle of all time, is not far east of here.

Just seven miles north of Laurel (Canyon Creek), is the location of the battle fought between the Nez Perce Indians led by Chief Joseph and the U.S. Cavalry led by Colonel Samuel Sturgis. This site is listed on the historic Nez Perce Trail—the trail taken on their trek to Canada. The organization, Friends of Canyon Creek, is working to have a historical walk-through display to be located at the site in the near future. The Nez Perce Tribal Veterans travel to Canyon Creek on or about September 13th every year in order to conduct a memorial at this site. The memorial is in honor of the Canyon Creek Battle and all Veterans of America's wars.

A little to the south, you will find the majestic Big Horn Canyon that holds Yellowtail Reservoir, unique for its sheer beauty and an adventure for boaters. Below that, is the river some call "The Finest Trout Stream in the World" — The Bighorn!

Or how about the northeast, where you will find the nation's largest earth-filled dam at Fort Peck, backing up an enormous reservoir on the Missouri River with some of the best fishing in the west.

Headed west? It's right out our back door. From Laurel west, the renowned Yellowstone River offers some of the finest trout fishing in the world. Drive north to the fabulous beauty of Glacier National Park near the Canadian border.

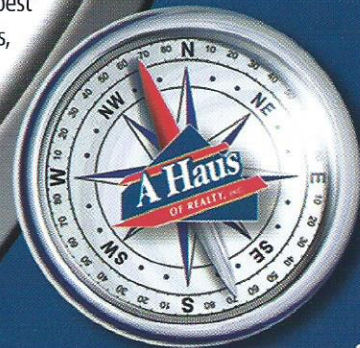

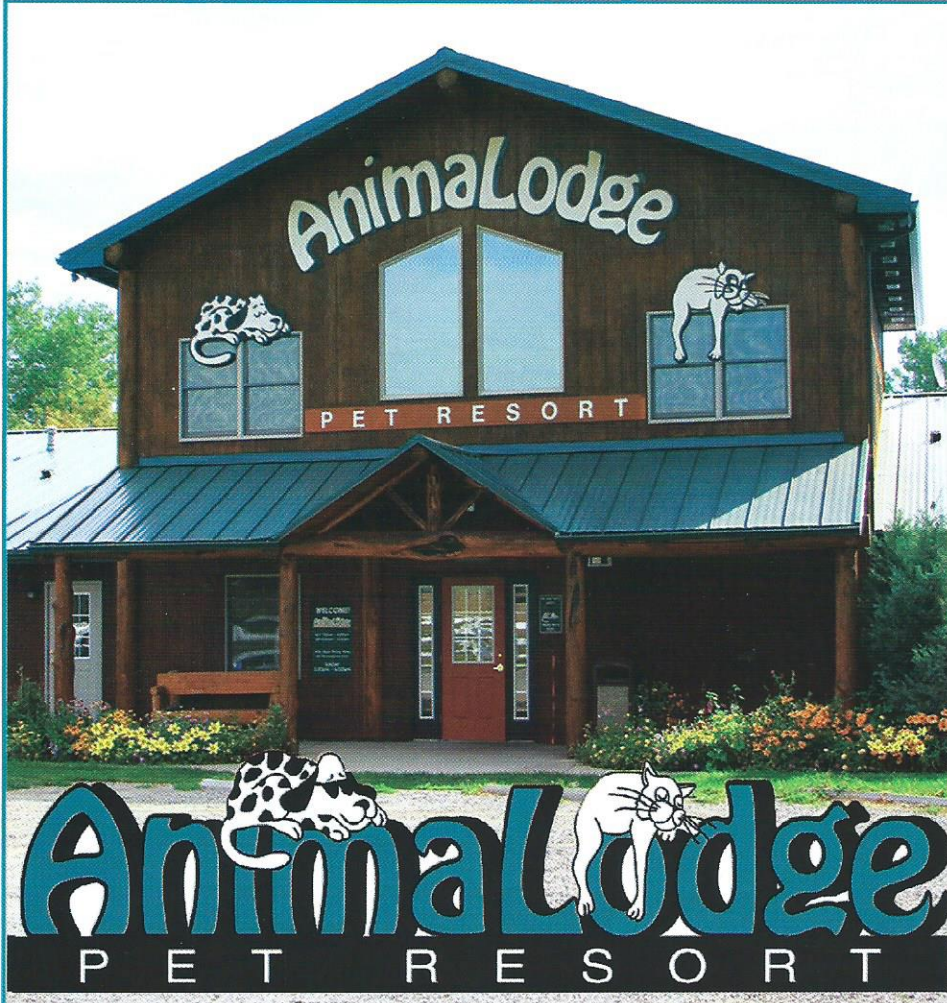

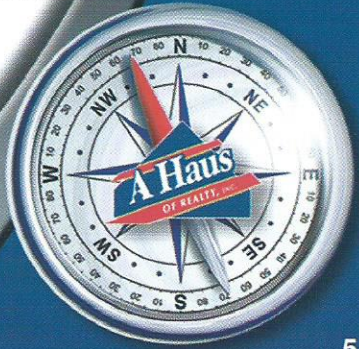

June through August

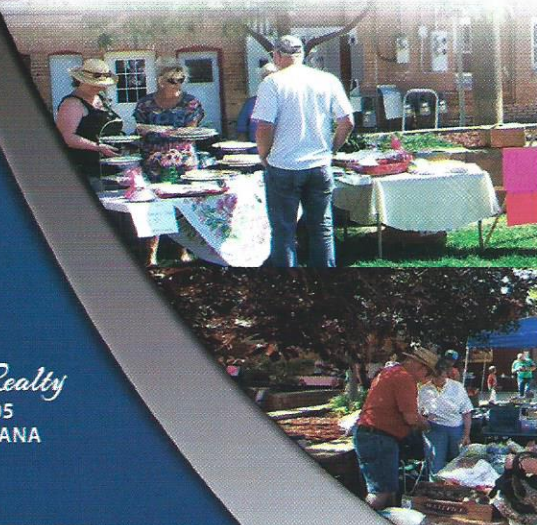

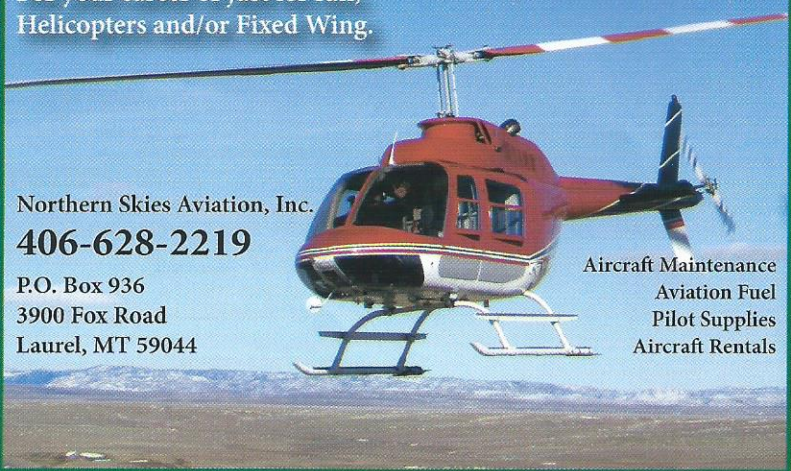

Laurel always goes all-out during the Fourth of July, and this year will be no exception. The Laurel Volunteer Fire Department puts on the largest fireworks display (historically) in the state, complete with a music show. Crowds at this event have topped 40,000!

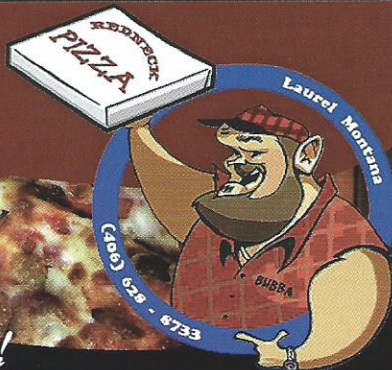
- ★ The Fourth is a fun-filled celebration in Laurel. Activities begin the night before on July 3rd with the Street Dance.
- ★ The next morning, the Jaycees sponsor a pancake breakfast beginning at 6:00 a.m. in Firemen's Park (Main Street and 1st Avenue).
- ★ The Laurel Chamber of Commerce sponsors an 8-mile run, 4-mile run, 4-mile walk, 2-mile run and 2-mile walk called the Chief Joseph Run that begins at 7:00 a.m. and starts at Thomson Park (1st Avenue and 6th Street).
- ★ A Kiddie Parade is next at 10:00 am, from Western Security Bank to Yellowstone Bank.
- ★ The Chamber of Commerce Grand Parade begins at 11:00 a.m. and runs from Alder Avenue and Main Street and loops around downtown to finish at the Laurel High School. Bands, Shrine units, floats, antique cars, horses, and class reunions color this parade.

- ★ After the parade, activities begin at Thomson Park (1st Avenue and 6th Street), runs through evening.
- ★ The grand finale of the day is the huge, dazzling fireworks display, the largest in the state of Montana presented by the Laurel Volunteer Fire Department.

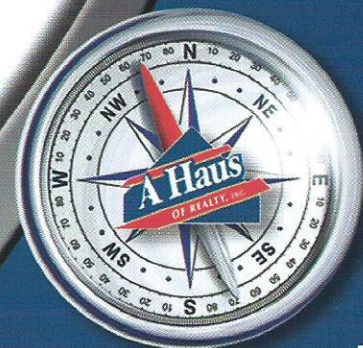

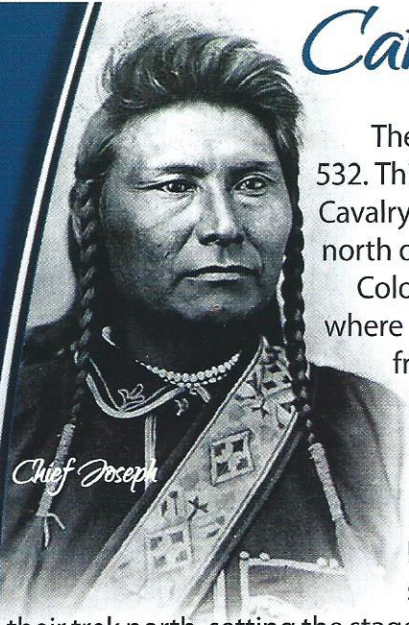

Canyon Creek Battlefield Memorial

The Canyon Creek Battlefield Memorial is about 10 miles north of Laurel on State Highway 532. This is the site of the culmination of a running battle between the Nez Perce and the 7th Cavalry Sept. 13, 1877. Much of the fighting took place in Montana, including the day-long fight north of present-day Laurel where Canyon Creek emerges from tree-lined canyons.

Colonel Samuel D. Sturgis encountered the Nez Perce on Sept. 13, 1877, in the broad valley where Canyon Creek flows. He attempted to stop the large party of Indians and their horses from the refuge of the canyon cover. The Nez Perce, under the leadership of their great military chiefs, Looking Glass, Yellow Bull, Tu-huul-huul-hutsiut, Husis-kute, Joseph, and others, beat Sturgis' cavalry to the canyon mouth, however, and won the day.

The 7th captured a large part of the Nez Perce horse herd thus slowing them down on their trek north, setting the stage for the Bear Paw battle later in the month.

There is an exhibit area at the intersection of MT 532 and MT 401. The pavilion has several interpretive signs to help visitors gain a better understanding of the conflict.

The Laurel Chamber of Commerce provides the decorations and banners that line the business district of Laurel. On the first weekend in December, the Christmas To Remember celebration includes a parade of lights down First Avenue, and Christmas music, business open house activities throughout the day. Santa Claus arrives in Firemen's Park directly after the Parade of Lights and Fireworks display in the park.

Laurel - a Rich History

There is a rich history that lends itself to Laurel. Calamity Jane settled in an area around Canyon Creek, seven miles north of Laurel. Also at Canyon Creek is the marker that tells of the battle fought between the Nez Perce and the U.S. Cavalry on September 13, 1877.

There is also a statue located in Firemen's Park, downtown, commemorating the great Nez Perce leader, Chief Joseph. In

Early Main Street 1806, Captain William Clark of the famous Lewis and Clark Expedition, camped at the mouth of the Clark's Fork River where it joins the Yellowstone River. This site eventually became the site now known as Laurel. The Chamber Log Cabin, located in Firemen's Park, was built in 1938 from plans provided by the Montana State Transportation Department. The Transportation Department intended to have log cabin tourist information centers built all along the interstate highways in Montana. This log cabin is the only known one still in existence and houses not only the Chamber office, but also the Visitor Information Center.

Riverside Park was the site of the German Prisoner of War Camp during World War II. A boat ramp and picnic areas are available. Riverside Park is city-owned and located south of the Yellowstone River Bridge.

Laurel is the home of the 1,000-mile checkpoint for the Montana Rail Link between here and Sandpoint, Idaho. There is a lot of railroad history here since the existence of Laurel, due in part to the railroad.

The south side of Laurel was once called "German Town" because the Russian-German people immigrated here and settled south of Laurel. These people built their homes

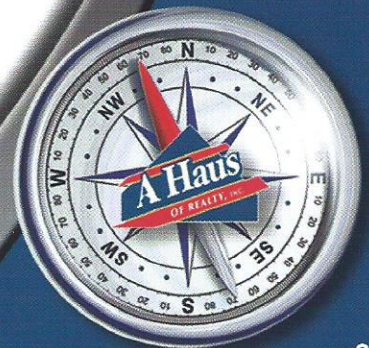

to resemble their homes in Russia. Some of them are still standing and many have been restored. This area of Laurel has unique character and charm.

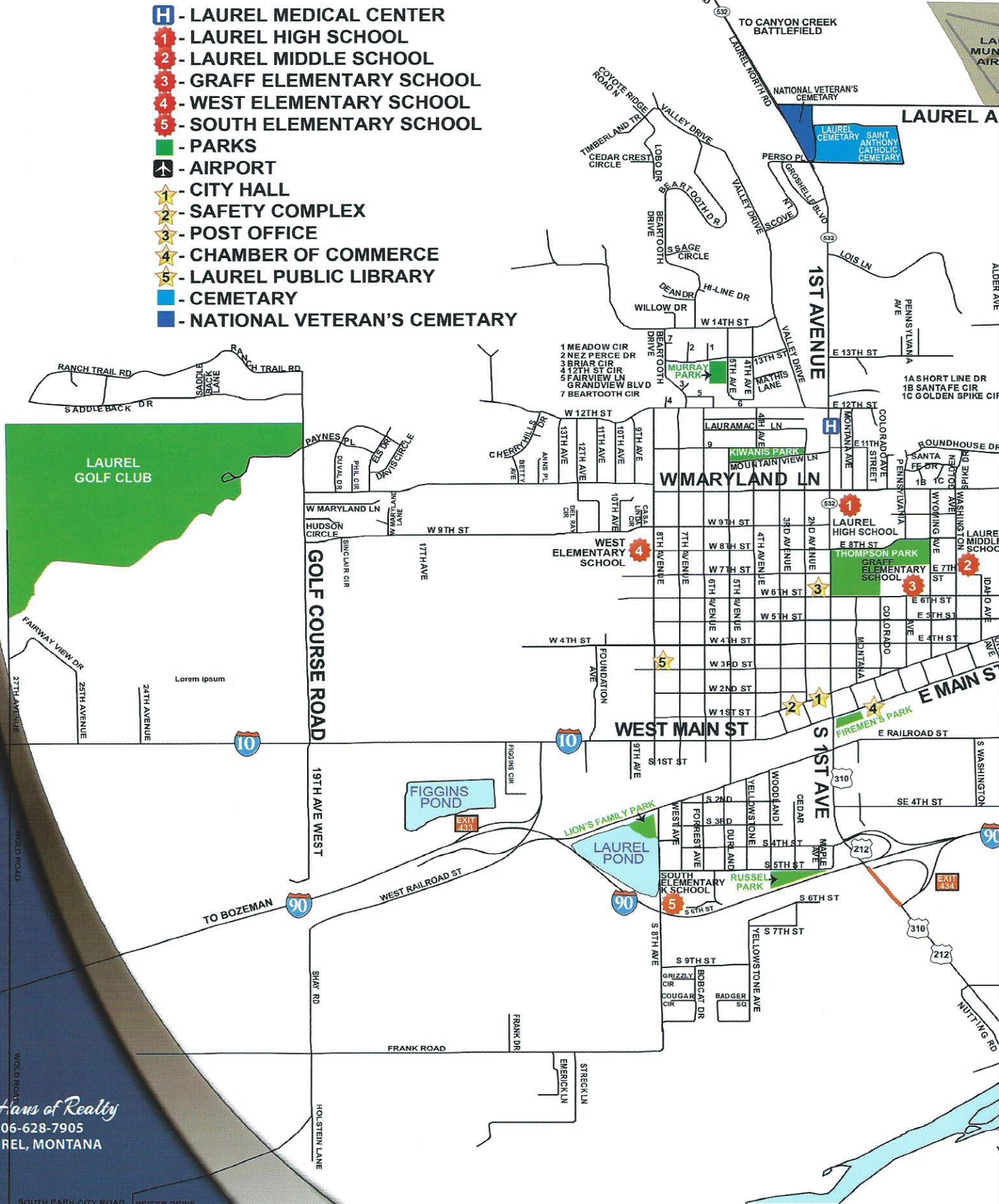
The name "Laurel" came from a name of a local shrub. Laurel was originally named Carlton, but was changed to Laurel in 1882. As time went on, the location of Laurel moved a little west.

in Laurel, Montana*

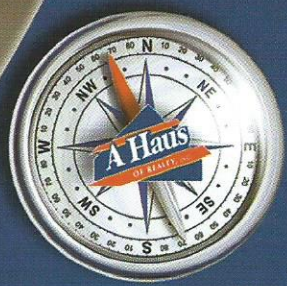

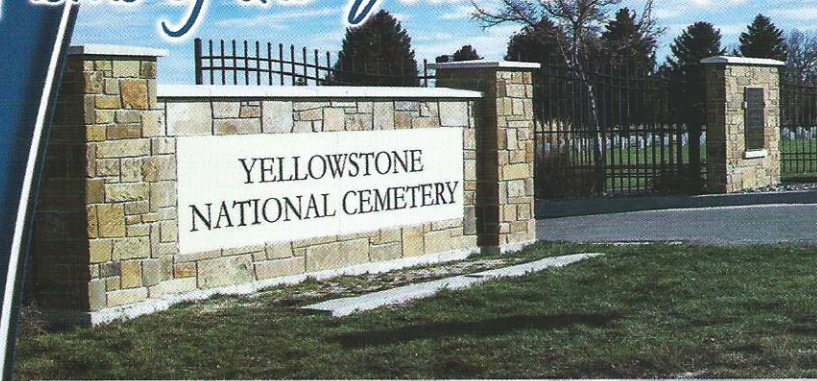

Future home of the Montana State Firefighters' Memorial Park



215 WEST 1ST STREET • LAUREL

The memorial is arranged in a key-hole shape, a cement path leading to a circle 343 inches in diameter, representing the 343 firefighters who lost their lives in the World Trade Center tragedy Sept. 11, 2001. The northwest arc of the circle is hemmed by three flags - the US flag, Montana state flag, and firefighters flag - and three 4' by 4' granite slabs, bearing the names of the fallen firefighters. Additional landscaping and statuary will be added as funds become available.

Air Transportation

Montana Rail Link still uses cabooses, which are used to carry remote control switching equipment on Laurel switch engines. MRL not only operates trains of its own to gather and distribute local freight along its lines, but also Burlington Northern Railroad cars that MRL receives at one end of its track and forwards back to BNSF at the other end.

Grain, forest products, and a special train called the Gas Local, are the primary commodities. The Gas Local runs between Missoula, Montana, and Thompson Falls, Montana, to bridge a gap in a long distance gasoline pipeline.
