BEER POURING

We request that breweries send 1-2 representatives to maintain the booth. Breweries seeking volunteers to serve their beer, with their equipment, should contact us at least 2 weeks in advance. We ask that you bring 2 kegs of your top 2 selling brews. Tapping a second keg needs approval by Brewfest staff.

BEER AWARDS

We will feature the ever popular **People's Choice** voting throughout the event, announcing the winners with an award around 7:30pm. Best of luck to all of you!!!

PROVIDED FOR YOU

Laurel Brewfest will provide your booth with an 8' table, voting receptacle, and ice as needed. Water stations for rinsing glasses are placed around the room.
